## Bachelor of (International) Journalism

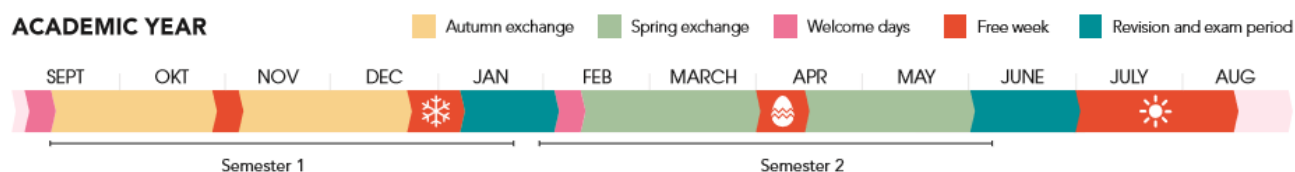
### Autumn Courses and Spring Courses for exchange students
